Funding Programs Target Business-Led Research

July 29, 2014, Fredericton, NB - New and updated funding programs are available to assist business with their research and development needs.

“Governments are encouraging businesses to increase their research and development activity so that they can increase exports and improve productivity,” said Eric Cook, Executive Director of RPC. “Funding programs are far-more business friendly with focus on commercial outcomes, streamlined application processes, and improved response times.”

Cook points to provincial programs such as the Innovation Voucher Fund and the Industry Innovation Challenge program. Federally, ACOA's AIF program announced changes in July that make it more attractive to industry. Genome Canada has recently introduced the Genomics Applications Partnerships Program (GAPP) targeted at commercial applications of genomics, and the National Research Council has added the Business Innovation Access Program to complement its globally-recognized Industrial Research Assistance Program (IRAP). These, and other initiatives, are targeted at market-driven research and development.
